Pursuant to Rule 5(b) of Order R-1670-C, Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application, in triplicate, for an exception to Rule 5(a) of said order and administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 15, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.

In support of this application, Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

1. The well to which this non-standard gas proration unit will be dedicated is the Aztec Oil & Gas Company Richardson No. 9-D, located seven hundred and ninety feet (790') from the north line and one thousand five hundred feet (1500') from the west line of Section 15.



2. Applicant owns all the acreage within the section on which the non-standard unit is located, as indicated on Exhibit "A" attached hereto. Other operators owning offsetting acreage are El Paso Natural Gas Company and Pan American Petroleum Corporation. Each has been furnished a copy of this application with the request that their consent in the form of a waiver of notice and hearing be forwarded to the Commission.
3. The non-standard unit consists of contiguous quarter quarter sections or lots.
4. The non-standard gas proration unit contains 301.02 acres and its unorthodox size or shape is due to a variation of the legal subdivision of the United States Public Land Survey.

Applicant respectfully requests that this application be promptly considered and that approval be administratively granted pursuant to Rule 5(b) of Order R-1670-C for the non-standard unit above described.

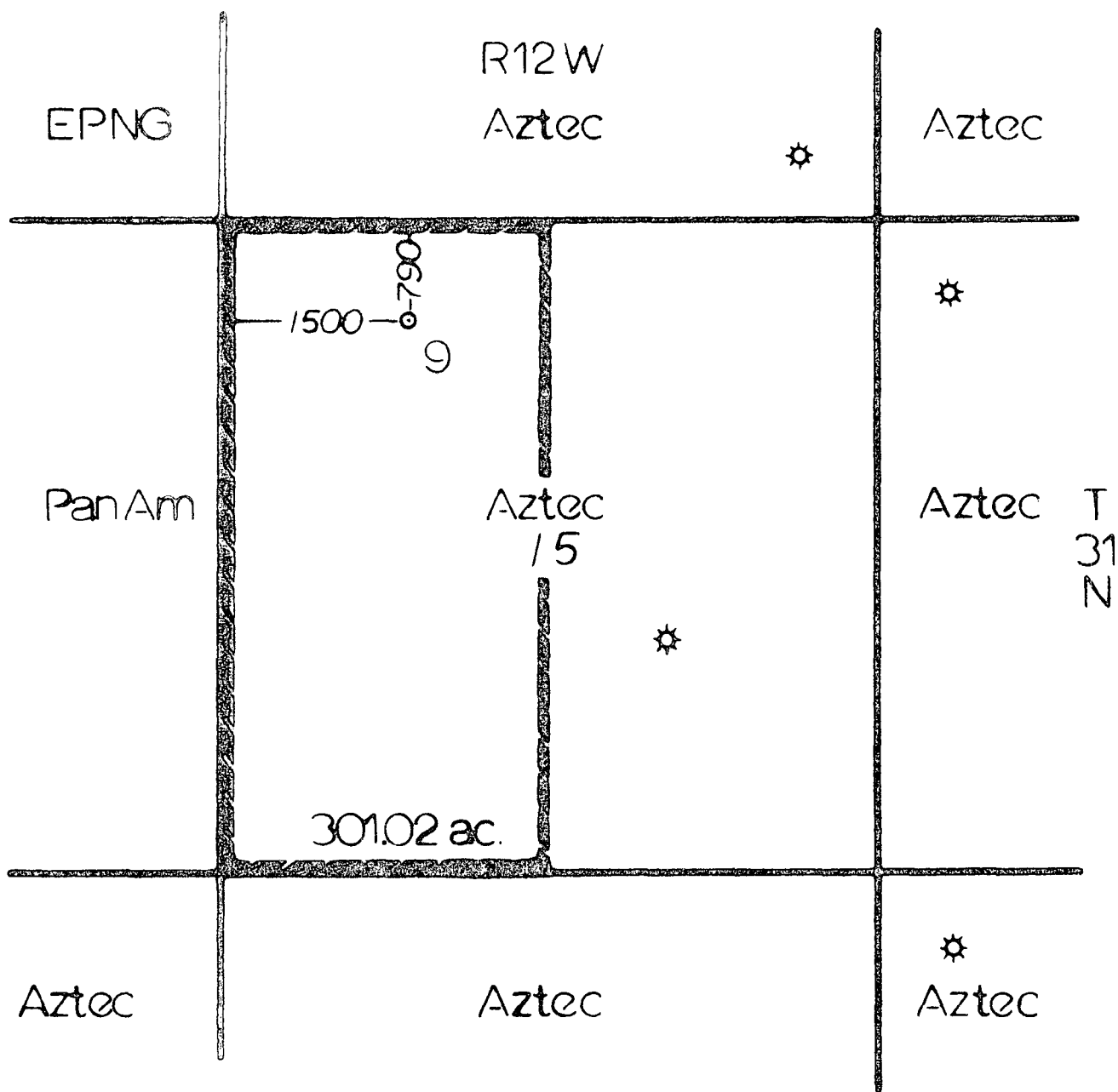


EXHIBIT "A"
