Pursuant to Rule 5(b) of Order R-1670-C, Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application, in triplicate, for an exception to Rule 5(a) of said order and administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the E_2^1 of Section 1, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico

In support of this application, Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

- 1. The well to which this non-standard gas proration unit will be dedicated is the Aztec Oil & Gas Company Dusenbury No. 3, located one thousand eight hundred and thirty feet (1,830') from the south line and one thousand and seventy-five feet (1,075') from the east line of Section 1.
- 2. Applicant owns all the acreage within the section on which the non-standard unit is located, as indicated on Exhibit "A", attached hereto. Pubco Petroleum Corporation is the only operator owning offsetting acreage and it has been furnished a copy of this application with the request that its consent in the form of a waiver of notice and hearing be forwarded to the Commission.

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- 3. The non-standard unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
- 4. The non-standard gas proration unit contains 315.58 acres and its unorthodox size or shape is due to a variation of the legal subdivision of the United States Public Land Survey.

Applicant respectfully requests that this application be promptly considered and that approval be administratively granted pursuant to Rule 5(b) of Order R-1670-C for the non-standard unit above described.


