Dear Mr. Porter:

I would like to ask approval of a Non - Standard Gas Proration Unit in the Ballard Pictured Cliffs Pool under terms of Order Number R-1670, Rule 5B, Paragraph 3. The Cinco Diablos #13 Well is located in "A" of Section 19, Township 23 North, Range 3 West, Sandoval County, New Mexico. This well was originally designated as the Keetom Apache #1, and has been changed to the Cinco Diablos #13 as of May 23, 1969.

Section 19 is composed of 2 Quarter Sections of 160 Acres each plus 4 lots on West side. Our well is in the North 1/2 of Section 19, which would include 160 acre Quarter Side plus 2 lots; one consisting of 18.91 Acres and one consisting of 18.94 Acres.

This acreage was originally surveyed by the Arizona Engineering Co. on July 6, 1954 and all surveys of the above described acreage are being used by all oil and gas operators in this area.

I own valid leases on the South 1/2 of Section 19, Township 23 N, R3W, the West half of Section 20, T-23 N, R3W, and am also enclosing copies of letters filed with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Santa Fe, indicating that none of the other adjoining



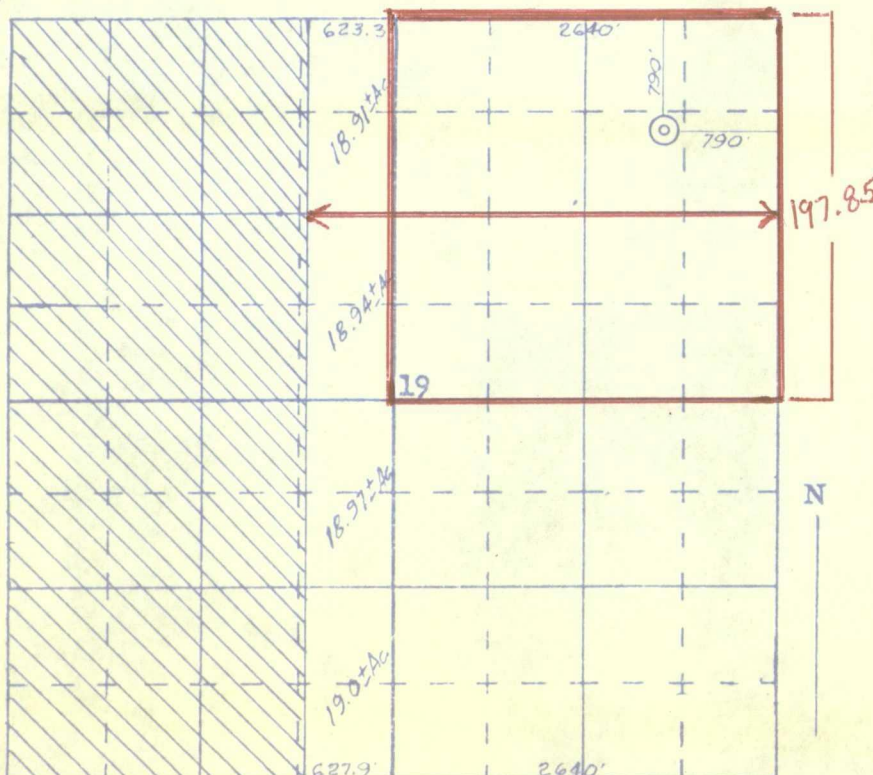
