Yates Petroleum Corporation is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from the Sand Tank; Bone Spring Pool (96832) from the following leases and wells.

Lease: Federal Lease: Bailout BOA

Wells: Bailout BOA Federal Com. Well No.1H (API No. 30-015-37168), 1770' FSL, 410'

FEL Unit I, Sect. 12, T-18-S, R-29-E

Lease: Federal Lease: Sand Tank APS

Well: Sand Tank APS Federal Com. Well No. 2H (API No. 30-015-37167), 460' FSL, 380'

FEL, Unit M, Sect. 12, T-18-S, R-29-E.

All in NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico

Commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Section 12, Township 18 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Gas production shall be measured continuously with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The gas allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly.

One meter shall be used to measure oil production from one well, and production shall be allocated back to each well using The Subtraction Method. The oil allocation meter shall be calibrated semi-annually.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules and Regulations. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.



This approval is subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land management (BLM) before commencing the commingling operations.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of commingling operations.
