Dear Mr. Bratcher:

Marshall & Winston, Inc. (M&W) herewith notifies the State of New Mexico, Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) that it received a Notice of Written Order (NWO) No. 11-JA-037W from the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) on a produced water discharge caused by a leaking valve on the southern most load line of said battery as cited above. However, actual infield operations revealed that an unauthorized discharge had occurred, as well, in the area which was later confirmed by conversations with the trucking company contracted to remove and transport oil field products from the battery.

Marshall & Winston proceeded with cleanup pursuant to the Corrective Action Plan (CAP) of 25 January 2011 which was followed by an infield assessment by both the NMOCD and the BLM to validated M&W's proposal on 10 February 2011. The agencies approved the proposal and remediation was conducted accordingly.

However on 10 February 2011 during the infield assessment, it was also noted that a second discharge had occurred at the pot area of the southern most tank and had likewise flowed off location partially onto the edge of the initial spill. This discharge showed evidence of a fire built just in front of the pot. Agency personnel discussed the fact that they did not want continuous discharges to occur here and mandated some form of lined, bermed barrier be installed to prevent further discharges from running off pad. Since excavation was on going at this time and it wasn't possible to separate the two discharges, remediation proceeded simultaneously with the construction of a berm (3'x 40') running along the west edge of the pad.

Therefore, a separate Initial/Final C-141 is submitted with this FRR solely for regulatory records. Laboratory analyticals, which were authorized by the respective agencies, are also included.


