**Administrative Order CTB-171**

**O Gentlemen:**

**P Reference is made to your application dated October 23, 1967,  
for an amendment to Administrative Order CTB-171 which, as amended,  
authorizes the commingling of Cato-San Andres production from your  
Cato "A" Federal Lease, your Cato "B" Federal Lease, your Cato "C"  
Federal Lease, your Cato "D" Federal Lease, and your Fischer Federal  
Lease in your Cato Storage System II, Chaves County, New Mexico.  
It is our understanding that you now wish to include Crosby "C"  
Federal Lease production in the same leg of the commingling instal-  
lation as the Cato "D" Lease production prior to commingling it  
with that of other leases in the installation, inasmuch as these  
two leases are of identical ownership.**

**Y Administrative Order CTB-171 is hereby amended to permit the  
commingling of the aforesaid Crosby "C" Federal Lease production  
in the commingling installation, provided that the production from  
the Crosby "C" and Cato "D" Leases shall be commingled, then sep-  
arately and continuously metered and sampled by means of a temper-  
ature compensated positive displacement meter with a non-reset  
counter.**
