Reference is made to your application dated January 13, 1969, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Eunice Grayburg San Andres production from your State "AN" Lease and your State "AX" Lease comprising the ME/4 ME/4 and SE/4 ME/4, respectively, of Section 16, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests.
