Marathon as operator of the aforementioned leases respectfully requests administrative approval for surface commingling, off lease storage and measurement of production for North Indian Basin Unit & Stinking Draw and surface commingling of Moc Federal Bone Flats Federal 12.

It is requested that surface commingling of "Upper Penn" production be approved for the North Indian Basin Unit production from SW/4; N/2 SE/4 & SE/4 SE/4 Sec 2, T-21-S, R-23-E (State lease E-7906-2), SW/4 SE/4 Sec 2 (State lease E-10170-2), and Stinking Draw lot 3, Section 36, T20 $\frac{1}{2}$ S, R-23-E (State lease K-1877), lots 1,2,4, S/2 S/2 Sec 36 (State lease E-10169).

Marathon proposes to surface commingle Upper Penn production at a central battery after separating and metering fluids through production separators dedicated to the lease. Three phase separators will be utilized to separate and meter oil, water and gas prior to delivering the oil, water and gas to the centralized facility. The attached drawing IHSC 050 0001 illustrates the typical separation equipment and drawing FEDBAT3 illustrates the proposed production battery and flow scheme for liquids processed and gas dehydrated & compressed in this facility.

Marathon has made notification to all parties owning an interest in these leases, including the oil purchaser, of the intent to commingle. Attached as part of this application is a copy of the letter submitted by certified mail to each party, the purchaser, and sundry notice to the BLM.

Production Facilities - Zone

Wells producing from the same zone will be connected to a production header. Each production header will be equipped with a three-phase production vessel to separate and meter oil, gas and water production.

*Oil production will be metered through a positive displacement meter. The non-resetting counter head will measure fluids in barrels. Taps will be installed to accommodate meter proving. The meter will be installed between the separator and dump valve to maintain a constant head pressure on the meter.

* Water production will be metered utilizing turbine meters. Taps will be installed to accommodate meter proving.

* Gas production will be measured using a six inch gas meter run and three-pen chart recorder (static, differential and temperature).

After separation oil, gas and water will be delivered to the consolidated battery.

Production Facilities - Test facilities

Wells will be periodically tested using a common test vessel. All lease production will be separated and metered in the same manner as described above. However, after metering the fluid will be recombined and returned to the wells respective production vessel for final separation and metering.

Production Facilities - Consolidated battery

Oil production delivered to the consolidated battery will be further processed through a heater treater prior to storage at the tank battery.

Water production from the field will be stored in tankage at the consolidated facility and then pumped into a disposal system.

Gas production delivered to the consolidated facility will be further processed through a dehydrator after compression but prior to delivery to a common trunkline system for further processing at a gas processing plant.
