The above named company is hereby authorized to commingle Denton Devonian Pool (I.D.N. 16910) production from the following leases:

Lease: J.M. Denton Lease
Description: S/2 Section 11 except SW/4 SE/4, Twp 15-S, Rge 37-E

Lease: Denton Well No.1
Description: SW/4 SE/4 of Section 11, Twp 15-S, Rge 37-E

All in Lea County, New Mexico.


Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each pool prior to commingling.

NOTE: The commingled production shall be stored in the J.M. Denton tank battery facility located in Unit Letter J of Section 11, Township 15 South, Range 37 East.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the supervisor of the Hobbs district office prior to implementation of the commingling process.
