Lease: Monument '12' State Well No.3
Description: NE/4 SW/4, Section 12, and;

Lease: Monument '14' State Well No.2
Description: NW/4 SE/4, Section 14;

both located Township 19 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.


Production shall be allocated to each lease by well tests. (If this method is to be authorized, all commingled production must be of identical ownership including working interest, royalty interest, and overriding royalty interest.)

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored in the Monument Abo Commingled tank battery facility located in Section 14, Township 19 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Hobbs district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.
