Administrative Order WFX No. 12 is hereby amended to authorize the injection of water into the Queen formation through your North Caprock Queen Unit No. 1 Well No. 7-14, located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 7, Township 13 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico, subject to the condition that injection in said well shall be through tubing and packer, and that said packer shall be set at 625 feet or deeper.
