The surface pipe censists of 480 feet of 84", 28 pound casing comented with 50 sacks. The oil string is 7", 20 pound casing set at 2667 feet and comented with 100 sacks. Water is to be injected into the Leco Hills sand at 2742 to 2792 feet through tubing and packer.

No well will be assigned an allowable greater than the amount of oil produced on the official test.

During gas-oil ratio test, each well shall be produced at a rate not exceeding the top unit allowable for the pool in which well is located by more than 25 percent. Operator is encouraged to take advantage of this 25 percent tolerance in order that well can be assigned increased allowables when authorized by the Commission.

Gas volumes must be reported in MCF measured at a pressure base of 15.025 psia and a temperature of 60 degrees F. Specific gravity base will be 0.60.
