ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Newmont Oil Company, has made application to the Commission on July 15, 1962, for permission to expand its Square Lake Grayburg-San Andres Water Flood Project in the Square Lake Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

- 4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

That the applicant, Newmont Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:
