ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-1244, Socony Mobil Oil Company, Inc., has made application to the Commission on May 16, 1963, for permission to expand its Vacuum Water Flood Project in the Vacuum (Grayburg-San Andres) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 17th day of May, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that no offset operators need be notified in connection with this application.
3. That the State Engineer Office has waived objection to the method of completing the subject wells for water injection.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-1244.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Socony Mobil Oil Company, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Socony Mobil State Bridges No. 31, C - 23-17S-34E
Socony Mobil State Bridges No. 62, M - 14-17S-34E
Socony Mobil State Bridges No. 82, I - 15-17S-34E
