### ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Water Flood Associates, Inc., has made application to the Commission on June 25, 1963, for permission to expand its State 14 Water Flood Project in the Artesia Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 10th day of July, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
- 4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
  - 6. That the application should be approved.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Water Flood Associates, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

State 14 Well No. 1 located in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 14, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM,

PROVIDED HOWEVER. That applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set well below the top of the cement surrounding the oil string of said well.
