ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Stanton Oil Company, Ltd. has made application to the Commission on January 21, 1964, for permission to expand its Queen Water Flood Project in the Turkey Track Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 5th day of February, 1964, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced waterflood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Stanton Oil Company, Ltd., be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following-described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Brainard Well No. 7W located in the SE/4 SW/4 and
Brainard Well No. 8W located in the SW/4 SE/4, both
in Section 34, Township 18 South, Range 29 East,
NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set well below the top of the cement surrounding the production strings of said wells.
