Dear Mr. Ramey:

After looking at this waterflood, the Artesia office and myself have made the following recommendations:


1. That injection into 3 wells (outlined in red on the attached map) could be started at any time as long as injection is through tubing and packer and the injection pressure is below fracture pressure.
2. That if a P & A well in Unit O is re-entered and properly plugged, two additional wells (located in the blue circle) could be injected into.
3. To reactivate injection in the remaining wells would require 5 wells to be re-entered.

After receiving your letter, Marbob Energy people requested a meeting at the Artesia office. This meeting was held on the 27th of April, and our recommendations set forth in this letter were explained to them.

The area had the bradenhead survey run and schematics of the well bores examined, and the recommendations made should prevent further problems.
