ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, General American Oil Company of Texas has made application to the Commission on October 7, 1965, for permission to expand its Grayburg-Jackson No. 2 Water Flood Project in the Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 22nd day of October, 1965, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, General American Oil Company of Texas, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Keely C Well No. 18 located in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 25, and Keely C Well No. 32 located in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 25, both in Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set at approximately 2900 feet in the production casing of said wells.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
