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ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER WFX NO. 226

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2268-B, Sinclair Oil & Gas Company has made application to the Commission on November 23, 1965, for permission to expand its Keel-West Water Flood Project in the Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 3rd day of January, 1966, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2268-B.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2268-B.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Sinclair Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Keel "B" Well No. 21 located in Unit J of Section 6 and Keel "B" Well No. 22 located in Unit L of Section 5, both in Township 17 South, Range 31 East,

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set at approximately 2750 feet in the production casing of said wells.
