## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2268-B, Sinclair Oil & Gas Company has made application to the Commission on January 10, 1966, for permission to expand its Keel-West Water Flood Project in the Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 21st day of January, 1966, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2268-B.
- 4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2268-B.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
  - That the application should be approved.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Sinclair Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

West "B" Well No. 30 located in Unit K of Section 9, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.

<u>PROVIDED HOWEVER</u>. That applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 3,000 feet in the  $4\frac{1}{2}$  inch casing in said well.
