Gentlemen:

We hereby make application for administrative approval to drill West Loco Hills Unit Tract 11 Well No. 11 as a water injection well. This well is to be located 2310' FNL and 1650' FWL of Section 11, T-18S, R-29E and to inject into the Grayburg formation.

The casing program is to set 8 5/8" or 7" casing at the top of the salt, expected at 430' and cement with 50 sacks. The oil string will be 4 1/2", 9.5# J-55 casing set through the oil zone, cemented with 100 sacks.

This well is in Stage II of the Development Plan as provided for in Order R-2178-B (Case 2578) and as amended by Order R-2178-C (Case 2805), the later order being dated June 11, 1963.

By attachment hereto is pertinent data in compliance with requirements as set forth by the above referenced orders.

A copy of this application has been sent to the State Engineer. Newmont Oil Company as operator of the only offset leases producing from the Grayburg 4 Sand (Loco Hills Sand) offers no objection to this well and hereby waives the fifteen day waiting period.

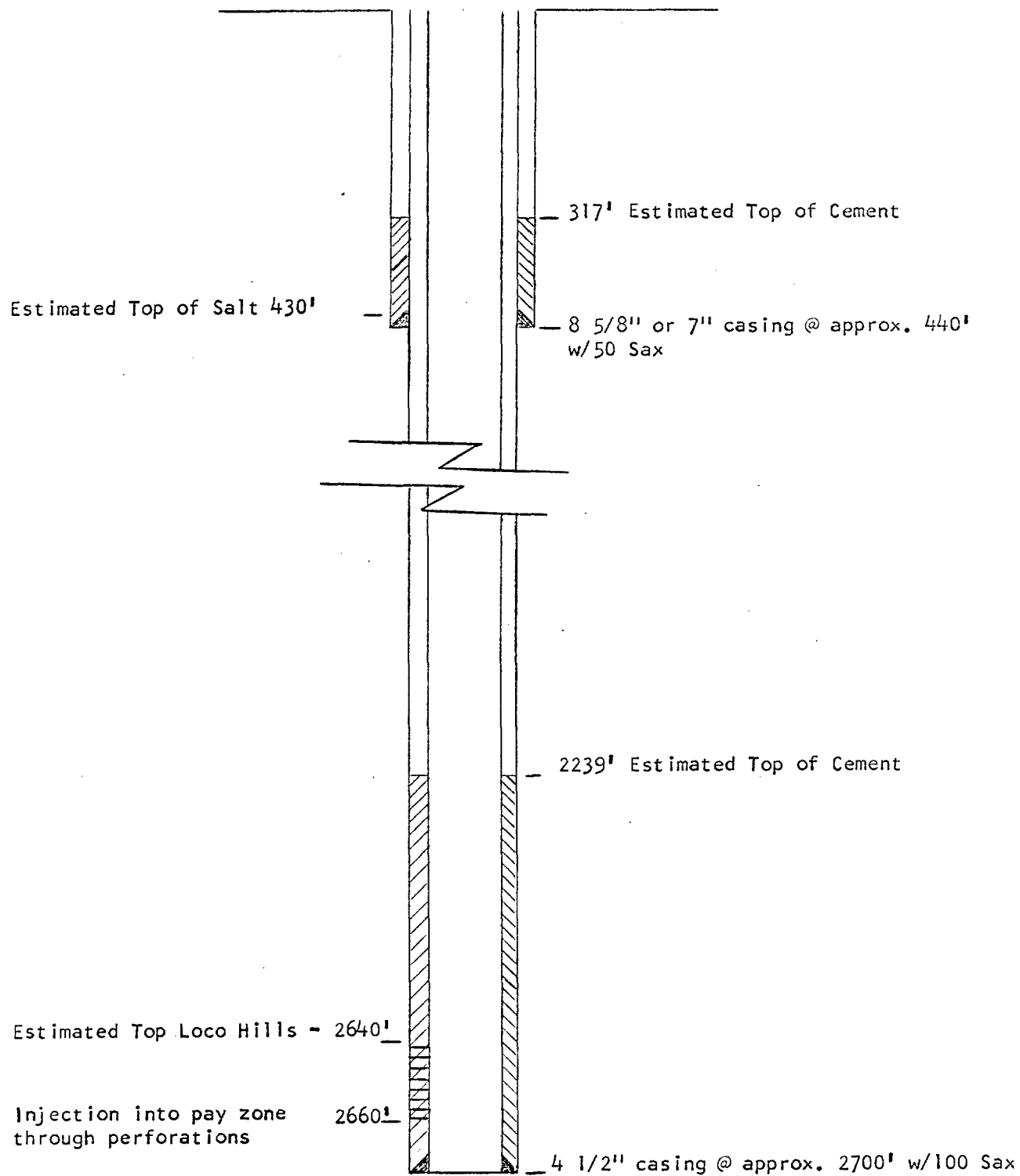

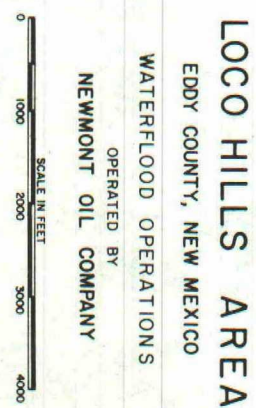
WEST LOCO HILLS UNIT
