ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3069, Tenneco Oil Company has made application to the Commission on October 16, 1967, for permission to expand its Grayburg-Jackson West Cooperative Unit Water Flood Project in the Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 31st day of October, 1967, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all off-set operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3069.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3069.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Tenneco Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following-described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 47 located in Unit C of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 2200 feet in said well.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
