ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3431, Shenandoah Oil Corporation has made application to the Commission on May 17, 1969, for permission to expand its Shenandoah Shugart Water Flood Project in the Shugart Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 1st day of June, 1969, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3431.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Shenandoah Oil Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Yates Seven Rivers Queen and Grayburg formations through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Shugart A-1 located in Unit M of Section 29, and
Shugart C-2 located in Unit O of Section 30, both
in Township 18 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.
