Gentlemen:

Enclosed are copies of correspondence with the Bureau of Land Management pertinent to the purchase by Carter Foundation Production Company of the Texaco, Inc., Blaine-Federal "B" NCT-4 Lease #032545, Lea County, New Mexico, for the purpose of expanding the current Blaine-Cade Waterflood Project. Purchase of this lease has now been consummated and we are advised by the Bureau of Land Management that this expanded injection operation must be approved by your office.

The Blaine-Cade Waterflood Project was approved by the Oil Conservation Commission on January 13, 1966, by Order No. R-3027. Inasmuch as our current plans are merely an expansion of this waterflood project, we request permission to proceed with conversion to water injection service of Wells #1 and #2 on the previously operated Texaco, Inc., Blaine-Federal "B" NCT-4 Lease #032545 (see enclosed plat).

The Carter Foundation Production Company plans to purchase at a cost of \$600.00 the wells on the Texaco, Inc., Blinobry-Federal "B" NCT-4 Lease #032545 (E/2 Section 35, T-23-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico) with the intent of converting Wells #1 and #2 to water injection service to expand their present Bline-Cade Unit water injection project. This Unit consists of the E/2 of Section 34 and the W/2 of Section 35, a west offset to the subject tract.

The Company will assume the liabilities of Texaco to plug and abandon the wells upon completion of their service for water injection purposes.

Permit is revocable for any breach of conditions or at discretion of the authorized officer of the Bureau of Land Management, at any time upon notice if, in his judgment, lands should be devoted to another use. This permit is subject to valid adverse claims heretofore or hereafter required.

2. Permittee shall pay the authorized officer as rental the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ dollars  
, in advance, or such other sum as may be required if an adjustment of rental is made.

3. Permittee shall observe all Federal, state, and local laws and regulations applicable to premises and to erection or maintenance of signs or advertising displays, including the regulations for protection of game birds and game animals, and shall keep premises in a neat, orderly, and sanitary condition.

4. Use or occupancy of the land under this permit shall commence within \_\_\_\_\_ months from date hereof and shall be exercised at least \_\_\_\_\_ days each year.

5. Permittee shall take all reasonable precautions to prevent and suppress forest, brush, and grass fires; and to prevent the pollution of air and waters on or in the vicinity of the lands.

#### 14. Special Conditions:

6. Authorized representatives of the Department of the Interior, other Federal agencies, and game wardens shall at all times have the right to enter premises on official business.

7. Permittee shall not enclose roads or trails commonly in public use.

8. Permittee shall pay the United States for any damage to its property resulting from this use.

9. Permittee shall immediately notify the authorized officer of a change of address.

10. This permit is subject to all applicable provisions of the regulations (43 CFR 2920\*) which are made a part hereof.

11. Permittee agrees to have serial number of this permit marked or painted on each advertising display erected or maintained under authority of such permit.

12. Permittee shall not cut any timber on lands without prior permission of the authorized officer.

13. This permit is subject to the provisions of Executive Order No. 11246 of September 24, 1965, as amended, which sets forth the nondiscrimination clauses. A copy of this order may be obtained from the signing officer.

#### INSTRUCTIONS

1. This application must be typed or printed plainly in ink. Submit in duplicate to any local office of the Bureau of Land Management having jurisdiction over the lands.

2. An application by a partnership or association must be accompanied by a statement by each member that he is a citizen of the United States or has filed a declaration to become a citizen. An application by a corporation must be accompanied by a statement showing the corporation is authorized to hold land in the State in which the land is located and that the person making the application is authorized to act for the corporation.

3. This application must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10 which is not returnable. Checks must be made payable to

the Bureau of Land Management. No filing fee is required if applicant is a Federal, state, or local governmental agency.

4. If this application is for permission to erect an advertising display or sign, the applicant must: (a) attach an accurate and fully descriptive diagram, sketch, or photograph (at least 3" x 5") of the sign display to be erected showing the dimensions, type of construction, estimated cost, the advertising material to be included thereon, the plan of illumination, if any, and the manner of attachment to the land; and, (b) a photograph (at least 3" x 5") showing the site on which the sign or display is to be erected.
