ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2403, Continental Oil Company has made application to the Commission on May 15, 1975, for permission to expand its MCA Unit Water Flood Project in the Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 19th day of May, 1975, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no offset operators.
3. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2403.
4. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
5. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:
