ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2278, Skelly Oil Company has made application to the Commission on December 22, 1975, for permission to expand its Lovington San Andres Unit Water Flood Project in the Lovington-San Andres Pool in Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 24th day of December, 1975, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other offset operators.
3. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2278.
4. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
5. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Skelly Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the San Andres formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
