ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4222, Tenneco Oil Company has made application to the Commission on January 12, 1976, for permission to expand its Lusk Seven Rivers Water Flood Project in the Lusk-Seven Rivers Pool in Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 27th day of January, 1976, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. 4222.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-4222.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Tenneco Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Seven Rivers formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Lusk Seven Rivers Unit Well No. 1, located in Unit J; Lusk Seven Rivers Unit Well No. 3, located in Unit D; and Lusk Seven Rivers Unit Well No. 4, located in Unit L; all in Section 3, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
