ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-516%, Burleson & Huff has made application to the Commission on November 15, 1976, for permission to expand its Querecho Plains-Queen Water Flood Project in the Querecho Plains-Queen Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 16th day of November, 1976. the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form;

2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other offset operators;

3. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. E-5168.

4. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
