Dear Mr. Morris:

Your request for an increase in the maximum surface injection pressure for the subject well has been reviewed. The step-rate test you submitted has been considered as valid data and was used in setting a maximum pressure limit. A surface reservoir fracture pressure of 3300 psi was derived from the step-rate test after interpreting the last two points on the graph as a new pressure/rate slope. Subtracting a 50 psi standard safety factor, a maximum surface injection pressure of 3250 psi has been set.
