**RE: Injection Pressure Increase,  
Maljamar Grayburg Unit (MGBU),  
Lea County, New Mexico**

Reference is made to your request dated April 12, 2000 to increase the surface injection pressure on two wells in the above referenced waterflood project. This request is based on step rate tests conducted on March 13, 2000 and March 26, 2000. The results of the tests have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following wells:
