ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2622, Atlantic Refining Company has made application to the Commission on August 11, 1964, for permission to expand its Many Rocks-Gallup Pressure Maintenance Project No. 2 in the Many Rocks-Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 26th day of August, 1964, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2622.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2622.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Atlantic Refining Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Navajo B-1 Well No. 12 located in the NE/4 SW/4 of
Section 8 and
Navajo 18-1 Well No. 16 located in the NE/4 NE/4 of
Section 18 both in Township 31 North, Range
16 West, NMPM.
