Gentlemen:

Effective December 15, 1968, the Canada Ojitos Unit #12 (A-22) oil well located in the NE NE of Section 22, Township 25 North, Range 1 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico produced the balance of oil used to frac and commenced producing new oil. A completion report and potential test has been filed with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission District Office, Aztec, New Mexico. The new oil produced during the first twenty-four hour period amounted to 73 barrels, however, the well has a greater producing capacity and will probably be a 400 to 500 barrel per day producer.

This new well is located in the Canada Ojitos Unit and off-sets the Pressure Maintenance Project Area as set out by New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order #R-3401.


We have prepared and enclosed herewith a plat showing the approved Pressure Maintenance Project Area shaded in red and the 320 acres dedicated to this well outlined in green. We feel that the Project Area should be expanded to include all of Section 22 (shown on plat cross-hatched in red).

Benson-Montin-Greer Drilling Corp. hereby requests the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to include Section 22, Township 25 North, Range 1 West in the Pressure Maintenance Project Area as set out in Commission Order #R-3401.

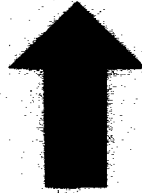
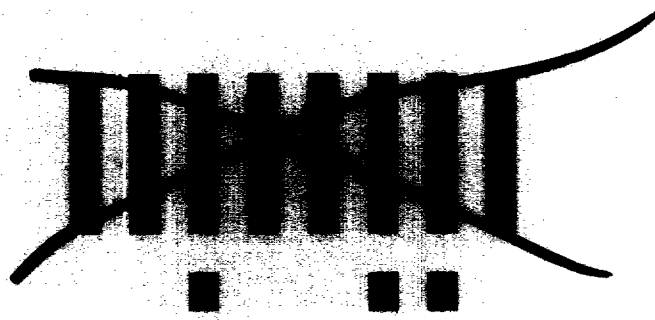
