Case 4793 Order No. R-4389 Expansion of Project Area Tenneco Lower Hospah Pressure Maintenance Project

McKinley County, New Mexico

## Gentlemen:

In our application of March 16, 1973 requesting administrative approval to expand the Lower Hospah Pressure Maintenance Project, we failed to designate the acreage that we wished to include in the expansion.

Order PMX No. 46, dated April 8, 1973, gave us permission to inject water into the expansion well; Whigham Well No. 2 located in Unit P of Section 11, Township 17 North, Range 9 West, NMPM.

The same thing has happened in regard to our currently proposed expansion and Order PMS No. 56, dated March 4, 1974. We have permission to expand the pressure maintenance project and to inject water into six proposed new wells, however, no acreage was dedicated to the project area.

We would like to include the following acreage under the appropriate expansions:

- 1. 80 acres; East half of Southeast Quarter of Section 11, T17N. R9W. NMPM.
- 2. 80 acres; North half of Southwest Quarter of Section 12, T17N, R9W, NMPM.

## PMX-56:

104.08 acres; lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Section 12, T17N, R9W, NMPM.

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The above described acreage is outlined on the attached map.

If it is necessary for us to make a new application for administrative approval to dedicate the above acreage, please let us know as soon as possible.
