#### Gentlemen:

Attached is our application to dispose of salt water into the San Andres interval in Brunson Argo No. 11. The 200 barrels of salt water we are proposing to dispose of daily is produced from our E. O. Carson, C. Hardy, H. Corrigan, and Brunson Argo leases in the Eunice Area.

Please note that cement did not circulate on the long casing string. A squeeze cement job has been done at 5000', which protects all zones below the proposed San Andres disposal interval. A squeeze cement job is proposed at a depth of 3930' prior to completing as a San Andres disposal well. This will protect producing zones above the San Andres. The San Andres interval between 3930' and 5000' will be perforated in several porous zones. Disposal will be through 2-3/8" cement lined tubing with a tension packer set at bottom of tubing at approximately 3950'.

Also attached find copies of letters to the offset operators, surface owner, and State Engineer's Office. If any additional information is needed, please advise.

It is our intention to dispose of water into the unproductive San Andres interval (3930' to 5000'). Enclosed is a sample copy of the application to be submitted to the Commission.


