Gentlemen:

In an effort to update our files regarding Salt Water Disposal Permits, we are requesting some information on the above-mentioned well. Our records show that your company was issued a SWD Injection Permit No. SWD-151 by us on December 28, 1973. Our records also show that since that time, this well has not been used for salt water disposal. Since a great deal of time has passed since your injection permit was granted, we assume that it is no longer your intention to use this well for water disposal purposes.

We are requesting information on the present status of this well, and whether or not your company intends to utilize this well for water disposal purposes at this time or in the near future. We would appreciate a response to this letter within thirty days. If we have not had a written response within that period of time, the injection permit granted by us will be rescinded.
