Reference is made to your request dated May 9, 1987 for a six-month extension to the well cementing requirement contained in Division Order SWD-299. This order authorized the use of the Dickenson Cattle Co. 33 Well No. 2 as a salt water disposal well provided that the Dickinson Cattle Co. 33Well No. 1 be cemented across the San Andres zone within six months after commencment of injection operations.
