The above named company is hereby authorized to commingle Southwest Teague Glorieta - Upper Paddock (Oil – 58595) and **North Teague-San Andres (Oil - 96197)** Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: R.R. Sims 'A' Lease Wells No. **2 (API No. 30-025-31538)** and 6 (**API No. 30-025-32944**)

Description: S/2 SW/4 of Section 4; and

Lease: B.F. Harrison 'B' Lease Wells No. 8 (**API No. 30-025-31955**), 10 (**API No. 30-025-32106**), 11 (**API No. 30-025-32107**), 14 (**API No. 30-025-32173**) and 18 (**API No. 30-025-32159**)

Description: NW/4 of Section 9;

Township 23 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each lease prior to commingling.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.


