LEASE: Florance D LS Wells No. 1 (**API No. 30-045-06342**) and 14A (**API No. 30-045-29246**)

DESCRIPTION: SE/4 of Section 21, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs (Prorated Gas – 72439), and Blanco-Mesaverde (Prorated Gas – 72319) Pool production from the above mentioned lease and to determine production from each pool by separately metering the production from the Florance D LS Well No. 1 and determining the Florance D LS Well No. 14A production by the subtraction method. Oil production will not be commingled. Fuel gas usage will be allocated equally between the two wells.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.


REMARKS: The commingled natural gas production shall be delivered to the El Paso Field Services CDP (#97929) located in Section 21, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.
