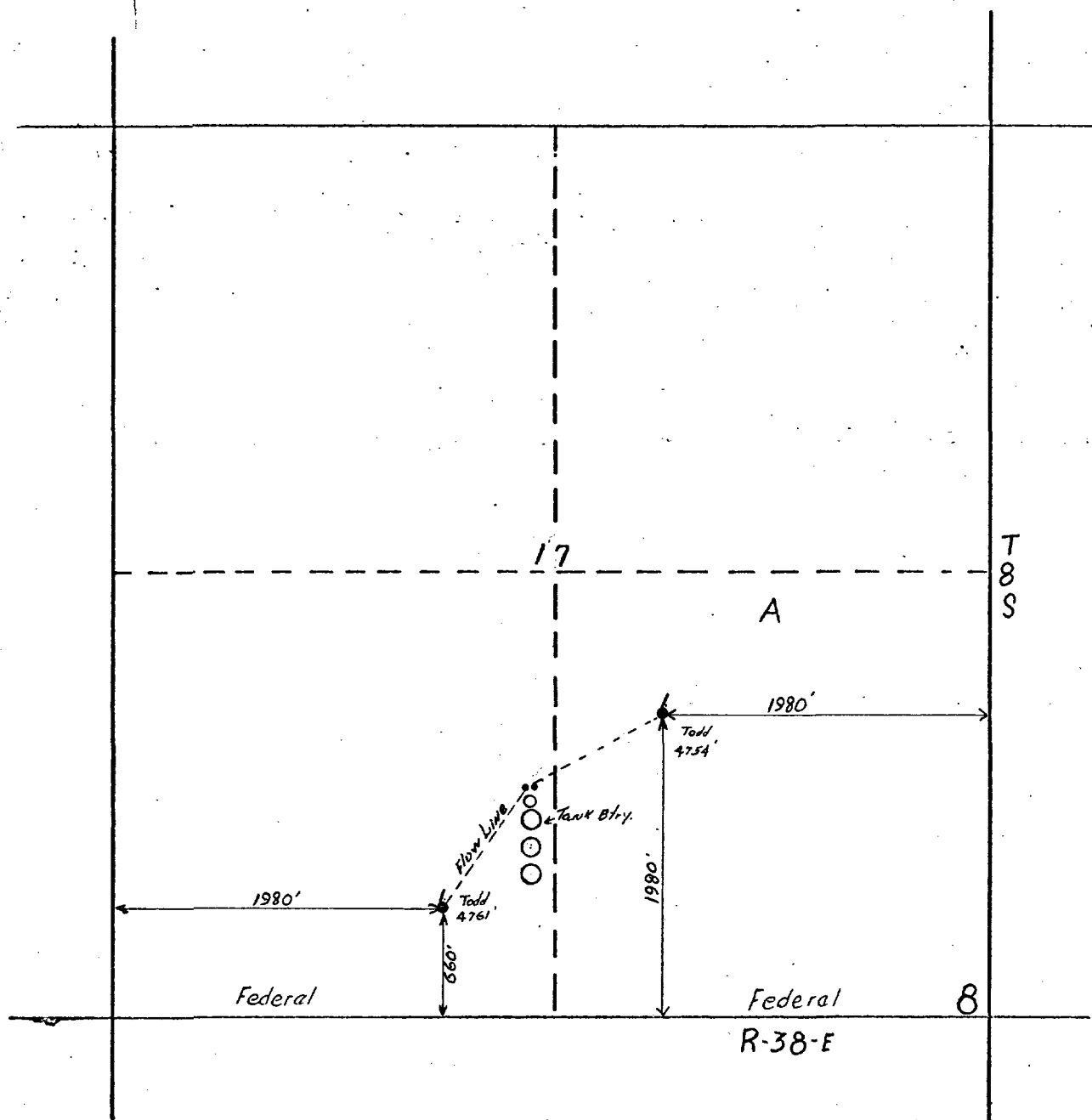

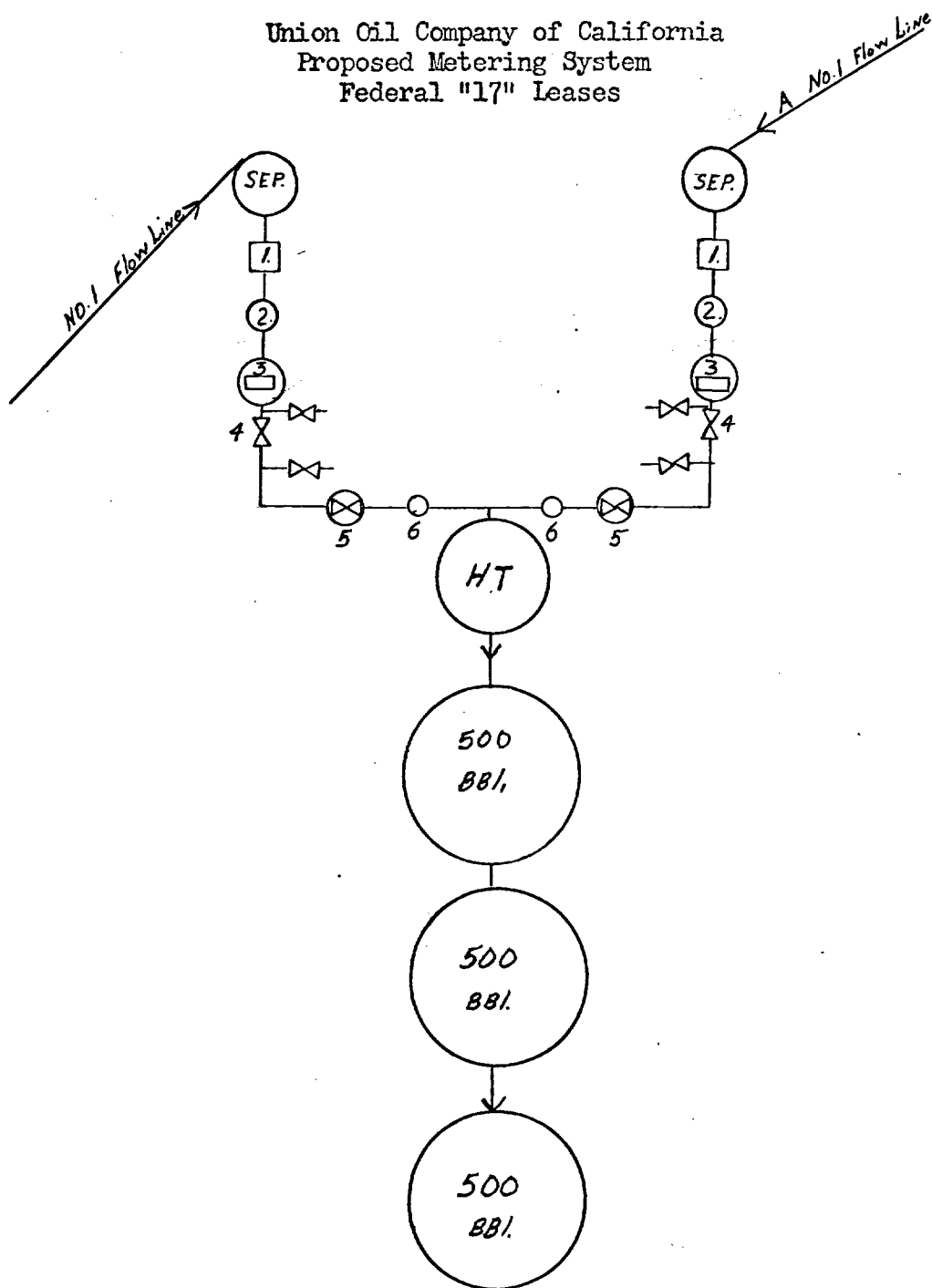
FEDERAL "17" LEASE

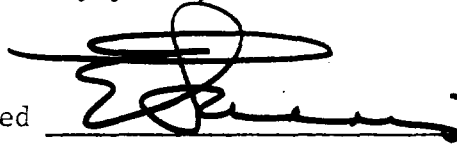

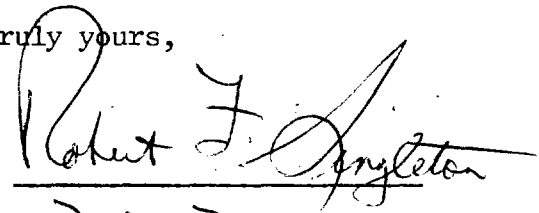
