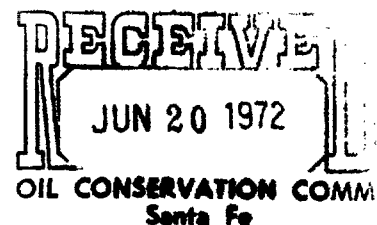
Please notify this office when the installation is completed and operative so that it can be inspected.
