

Gentlemen:

In accordance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule 309-B, TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A to permit comminaling of hydrocarbon production from the Vacuum North Abo Pool between New Nexico "DJ" State and New Mexico "W" State Leases consisting of the SE/4 of Section 13, T-17-S, R-34-E, and the N/2 of Section 18, T-17-S, R-35-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The Working Interest and Royalty Interest are all common between leases. Therefore, it is proposed that the production of the New Mexico "DJ" State Lease be routed to the central battery to be located on the New Mexico "W" State Lease and production be commingled. Production will be allocated to each lease on a periodic well test basis for which adequate well testing facilities will be provided. A schematic diagram of the proposed commingling installation and plat of the leases showing all wells and the formation in which they are completed are attached.

The State Land Office as Royalty Interest Owner and Mobil Pipeline Company as purchaser of production are being furnished a copy of this application. NMOCC






