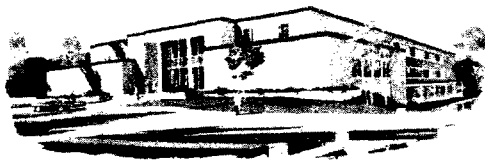

The State Land Office as Royalty Interest Owner and Mobil Pipeline Company as purchaser of production are being furnished a copy of this application.


