Gentlemen:

Cabot Corporation hereby requests administrative approval of exceptions to Rules 303(a) and 309-A to permit commingling in common facilities of oil and gas produced from Cabot's John R. Thompson lease. This involves commingling of production from two or more leases and two separate common sources of supply (North Bagley Upper Penn and Wolfcamp).

The exception is requested for Cabot's John R. Thompson No. 1, a North Bagley Wolfcamp producer, and the central tank battery located on Cabot's Humble-State lease. Data on liquid values are shown below:

As shown above, value of production from the individual zones will not be lessened by commingling.



Your early approval of this application will be greatly appreciated.





Cabot Corporation is making application to the Oil Conservation Commission for approval of exceptions to Rules 303(a) and 309-A to permit commingling of production from Cabot's John R. Thompson lease (SW/4 Section 23, T115, R33E, Lea County) into a central tank battery located on our Humble-State lease ($\mathbb{K}/2$ MW/4 Section 23, T115, R33E, Lea County). This involves commingling of production from the North Bagley Wolfcamp and Upper Penn common sources of supply.

Insemuch as commingling of oil production from the Thompson lease into a common tank battery will involve commingling of fee royalty oil with State royalty oil, we hereby respectfully request the Land Department grant the required waiver.

Gravity of the oils to be commingled are 46° and 47° API, both with a value of \$2.97 per barrel. There will be no lessening of value of the oil produced and commingled.
