Gentlemen:

Cabot Corporation hereby requests administrative approval of exceptions to Rules 303(a) and 309-A to permit commingling in common facilities of oil and gas produced from Cabot's John R. Thompson lease. This involves commingling of production from two or more leases and two separate common sources of supply (North Bagley Upper Penn and Wolfcamp).

The exception is requested for Cabot's John R. Thompson No. 1, a North Bagley Wolfcamp producer, and the central tank battery located on Cabot's Humble-State lease. Data on liquid values are shown below:

As shown above, value of production from the individual zones will not be lessened by commingling.

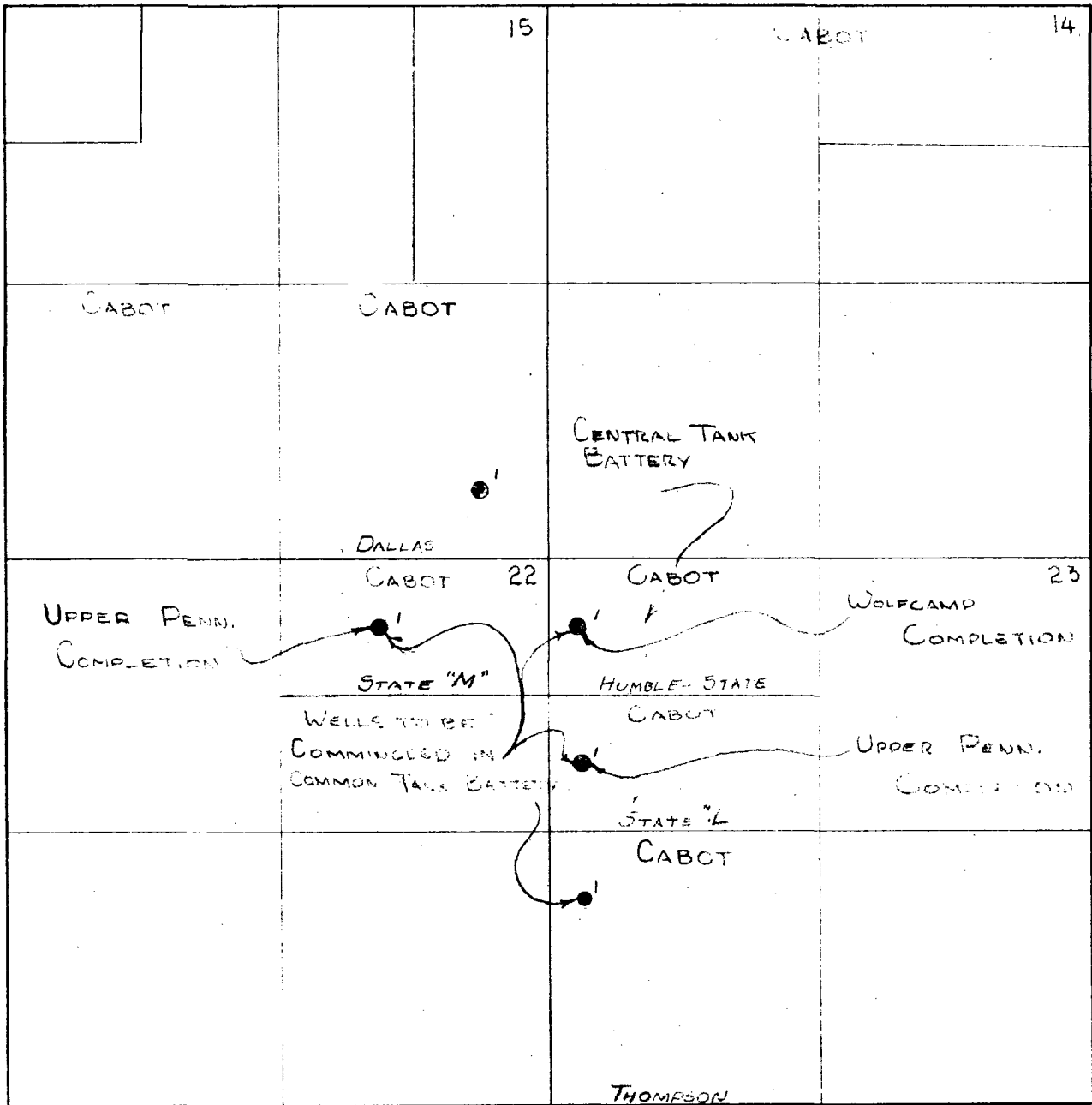

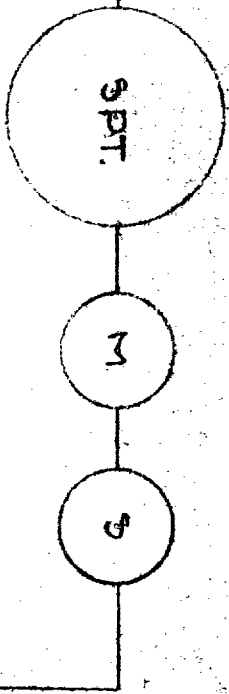

SECTION \_\_\_\_\_ TOWNSHIP 11 S RANGE 33 E COUNTY LEA STATE N. MEXICO

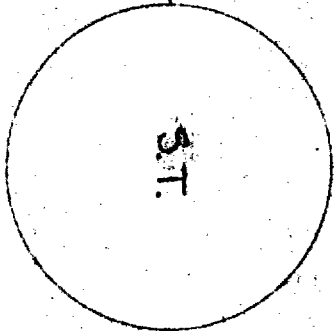
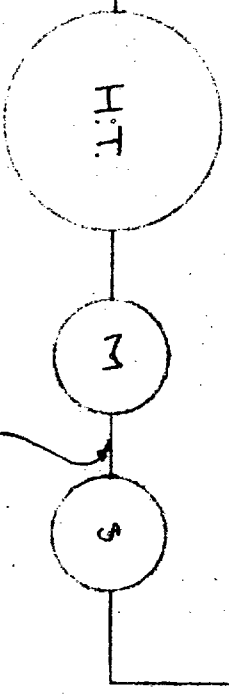


LOCATION PLAT

UPPER PENN ZONE

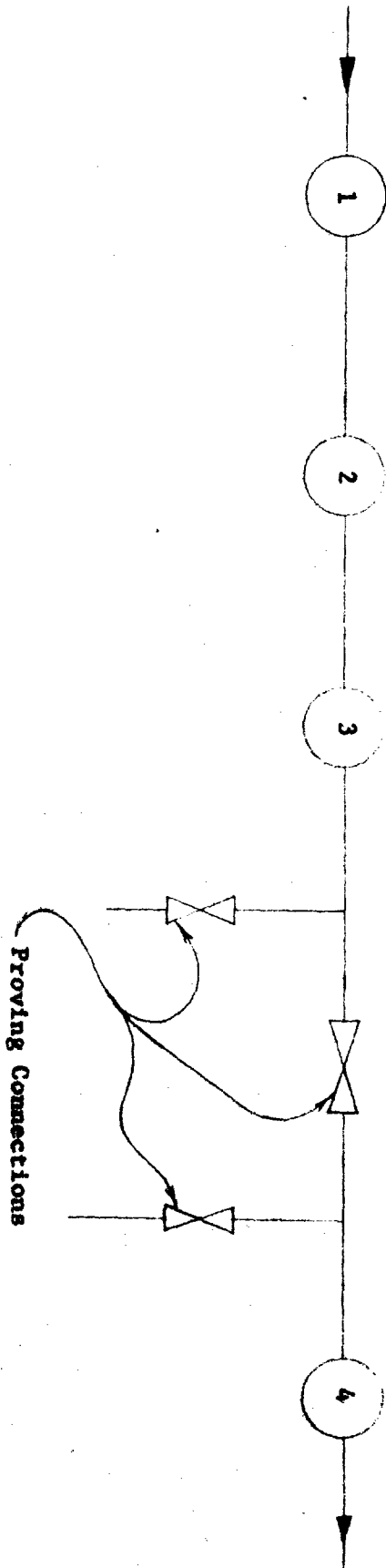





Cabot Corporation is making application to the Oil Conservation Commission for approval of exceptions to Rules 303(a) and 309-A to permit commingling of production from Cabot's John R. 
