Dear Mr. Bedingfield:

Reference is made to your application dated June 6, 1963, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the Empire Pool production from your State B-1, located in Unit M of Section 36, Township 17 South, Range 27 East and the Red Lake production from your Bedingfield-State 3, also located in Unit M of Section 36, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities"; and provided further, that you shall immediately notify the Commission at such time as any well in either pool is capable of top allowable production.
