## Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated January 9, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Vacuum-Abo, Vacuum-Pennsylvanian, and Vacuum-Wolfcamp production from your Santa Fe Well Mo. 87 located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Abo and Pennsylvanian production and determining the Wolfcamp production by means of the subtraction method.
