AMENDMENT  
Administrative Order PC-183

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of February 5, 1964, wherein you request that Administrative Order PC-183 be amended to delete the requirement for separate measurement of the Penrose-Skelly production prior to commingling with the Paddock production on your S. E. Long Lease. It is our understanding that the production from both pools on said lease is marginal and that you now propose to allocate the production to each pool on the basis of periodic well testing.

Administrative Order PC-183 is herewith amended to delete the metering requirements. Provided however, that the installation shall continue to be operated in accordance with the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities"; and provided further, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in either pool is capable of top allowable production.
