Gentlemen:

Please refer to Administrative Order PC-188 granting Shell Oil Company permission to commingle the Vacuum Blinebry with the Vacuum San Andres on our Swigart Lease (NE/4 SE/4 Sec. 25, T-17-S, R-34-E) after separately metering the Blinebry production. We plan to recomplete our one Blinebry well to the Vacuum Glorieta zone and propose to commingle its production with the San Andres using the same facilities which previously handled the Blinebry zone. Since both the Glorieta and San Andres are sour and have a similar gravity range there will be no change in revenue due to commingling.

Since the production facilities will remain as specified in our original application, we respectfully request an amendment to PC-188 granting Shell permission to commingle the aforementioned Glorieta and San Andres zones.
