Amendment
Administrative Order PC-231

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of January 25, 1965, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-231 which permitted the commingling of Blinebry and Paddock production on your Walter Lynch Lease comprising the NW/4 of Section 1, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Blinebry production and determining the Paddock production by means of the subtraction method. It is our understanding that all production from both pools is of marginal nature, and that you wish to commingle, allocating the production to each pool on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-231 is hereby amended in the above-described manner, provided however, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in either of the aforesaid pools is capable of top allowable production.
