Reference is made to your application dated October 21, 1964, for administrative approval for an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the Abo and Glorieta production on your Vac Edge Unit in Sections 3,4,5,9, and 10, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, Vacuum Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Glorieta production and determining the Abo production by means of the subraction method.
